English

Class and Home Reader - The Worst Witch by Jill Murphy

Narrative: Traditional Tales and Aliens in Underpants

Poetry - Planets Poetry.

Non-fiction - Instructions

Grammar - developing sentence structure through different genres. Using full stops and capital letters correctly. Developing use of 'and' to join two sentences and recognising an exclamation sentence.

Phonics - daily phonics sessions, recognising phonemes, blending and identifying alternative graphemes.

Handwriting - pencil grip, even sizing and spacing, begin to form letters correctly.

Maths

Number bonds to 10 and 20.

Understand place value to 100 using Numicon.

Understand one more and one less / 10 more and 10 less.

Money - recognising coins and finding totals.

Time - Read the time to the hour and half hour on analogue clocks.

Measures - recognise and measure using non-standard units.
