Dear Parents / Carers

We will be offering the following clubs the week beginning Monday 16 April 2018 up to and including the week beginning 21 May 2018 (excluding Friday as this is an INSET day).

To book on to one or more of the courses please fill in the form below and return to the school office with payment of cash or cheque (Payable to Active Bodies) in a named envelope, or email sparsons@activebodiesuk.co.uk to reserve a place and be given the BACs details to make an online payment.

The reply slip needs to be returned to school, even if you have contacted Active Bodies directly. Slips will need to be in school by 9am Friday 13 April 2018. No children will be added to the registers after this time. If you don't hear from a member of staff your child has a place. We will only contact you if your child does not have a place on the course.

Children will need to come to school with a change of clothes appropriate for the club they will be attending and a drink of water in a plastic bottle. Sherborne Site children (Reception, Years 1 and 2) will be changed in a classroom on the infant site at the end of the day supervised by staff and then escorted across to the junior site. Parents can then collect their child from the front waiting area of the junior site at 4.30pm. Parents will not be allowed to stay and watch any clubs.

If your child would normally attend Forum, a Forum member of staff will collect children from clubs that finish at 4.30pm but it remains your responsibility to inform the Forum manager that you would like your child to be collected from the club.

Wednesday 3.30pm-4.30pm	Rounder's Year 3, 4, 5 and 6.
Friday 3.30pm-4.30pm	Gymnastics Reception, Year 1 and 2.
