This half term the teaching and learning will be based around the theme

### **'Let's Get Moving'**

## Letters and sounds

**Miss Johnson:** We have learnt the spilt digraphs **i\_e** as in **time**, **o\_e** as in **tone** and **a\_e** as in **snake**. We have learnt to spell the tricky words **some**, **come**, **were** and **there**. We have applied these, as well as taught tricky words, when reading and writing sentences.

**Mrs Jones:** We have learnt to read and write two-syllable words with adjacent consonants e.g. **lunchbox**, **windmill**. We have learnt to spell **they**, **all** and **are**. We have learnt to read **do**, **when**, **out** and **what**. We have applied these sounds when reading and writing sentences.

**Mrs Cheshire:** The children have revisited the digraph **ar** as in **car** & **farm** and learnt the digraph **or** as in **corn** and **sort**. They have also been introduced to the tricky words **her**, **they**, **all** & **are**.

**Mrs Geary:** The children have revisited the digraph **oo** as in **boot** and **book** and learnt the digraph **ar** as in **card** and **farm**.

## Number Groups

**Mrs Cheshire and Miss Johnson:**

This week the children have been learning about counting on to add. The children have explored this practically using tens frames and have jumped on spots to count on.
