Doctor Visit

Many thanks to Dr. Ferguson for coming into school on Monday 18 June to talk to the children about her role as a doctor and what she keeps in her bag!

Letters and sounds

Miss Johnson: We have learnt the spilt digraphs **u_e** as in **cube** or **prune**, **e_e** as in **complete**. We have applied these, as well as taught tricky words, when reading and writing sentences.

Mrs Jones: We have learnt to read and write words with adjacent consonants e.g. think, spring. We have learnt to read **do**, **when**, **out** and **what**. We have applied these sounds when reading and writing sentences.

Mrs Cheshire: The children have revisited the digraph **or** as in **corn** and **sort** and introduced to the sounds **ur** as in **hurt** and **burn**.

Mrs Geary: The children have revisited the digraph **or** as in **corn** and **torn** and been introduced to **ur** as in **turn** and **fur**.
