Teaching and Learning This Week

This week the teaching and learning has been based around the Nursery Rhymes Baa Baa Black Sheep and Incy Wincy Spider. The children have collaged sheep, used pipe cleaner to create spiders, played an Incy Wincy game and drawn their favourite nursery rhyme. They have also had the opportunity to engage within other 'Nursery Rhyme' themed learning activities.

Ideas for learning at home

Sing nursery rhymes with your child and encourage them to do this independently.

Play with your child "I spy with my little eye something that rhymes with...."

Practise the formation of s & a.

Outdoor Learning

Please remember that tomorrow, Friday 28 September is our first outdoor learning session. Please refer to the letter issued last week for further guidance on what your child requires.

Letters and sounds

Red Room and Blue Room:

Learn the phoneme and graphemes for s & a. The children have been listening for these sounds in words, exploring how we can read words with these phonemes (robot arms - segmenting and blending) and practising writing the grapheme for both s & a

Number Groups

Red Room and Blue Room:

The children have learnt to count to 5 and then 10 accurately. They have used numicon shapes to explore number further, matching the number of objects to the numicon shape.

They have also explored number songs to help develop their understanding of number.
