## Teaching and Learning This Week

This week the teaching and learning has been based around the theme 'Good to be me - Growing up'. The children have written about what they would like to be when they grow up, created split pin people in different jobs, explored the length of shoes and sequenced the lifecycle of humans. They have also had the opportunity to engage within other 'Good to be - Growing up' themed learning activities.

### Ideas for learning at home

Try to make CVC words using the sounds s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c, k, e, u, r, h and b. Focus on the sound and name for each letter.

Focus on finding the tricky words I, the, to, no and go in books.

## Letters and sounds

Red Room and Blue Room:

Learn the phoneme and graphemes for **b**. The children have been listening for these sounds in words, exploring how we can read words with these phonemes (robot arms - segmenting and blending) and practising writing the grapheme for **b**.

## Number Groups

Children have been focussing on adding one more to a number using a part whole model. We have also begun to explore the numbers that go together to equal 5 and completed afternoon challenges comparing 2 groups of objects using the language 'more' and 'fewer'.
